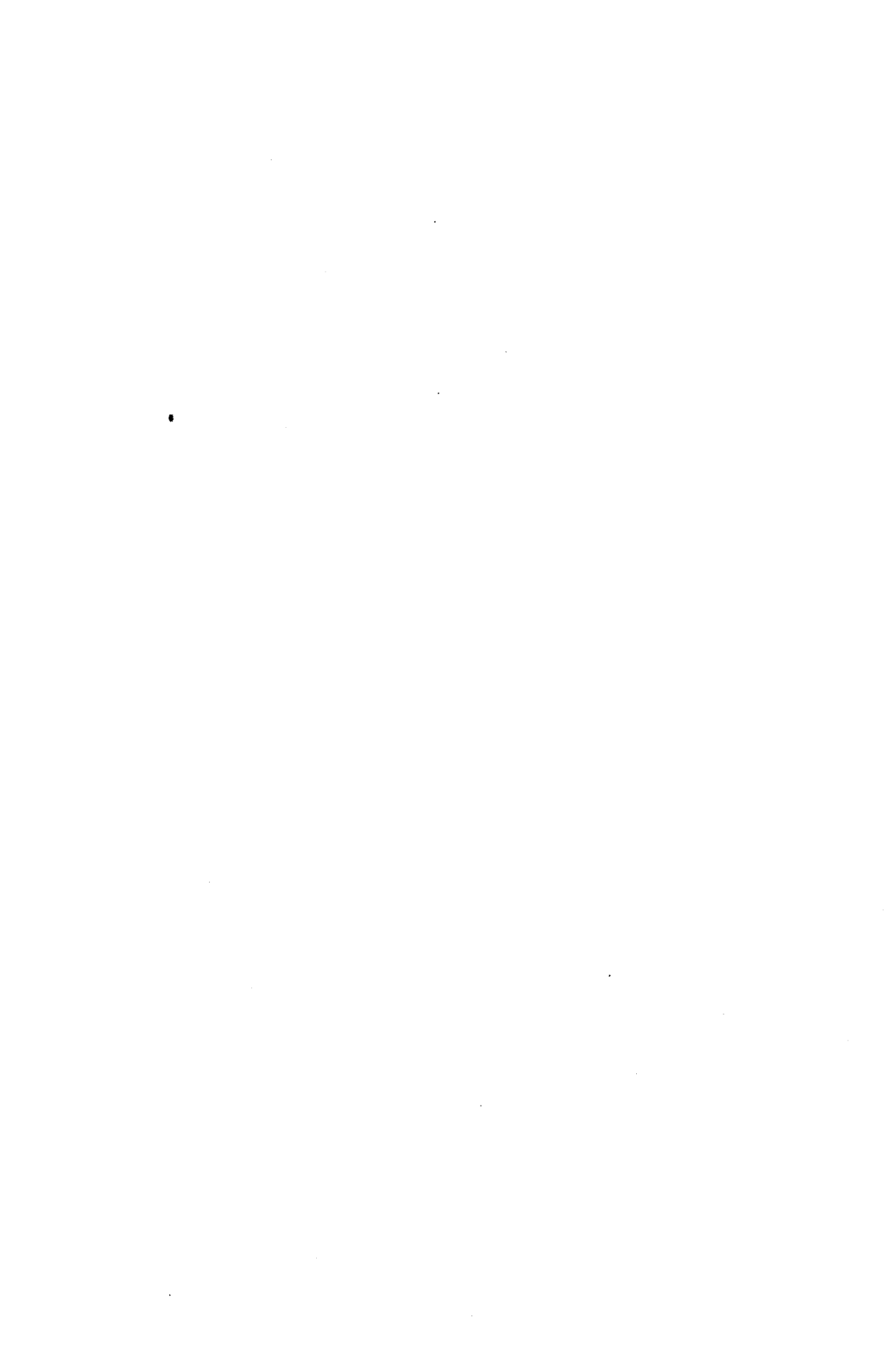
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to secure the Better Observance of the Lord's Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever on the Lord's Day, in any city,
2 town or organized place, fires or discharges any rifle, shotgun,
3 revolver, pistol or other fire arm, except as an act of necessity,
4 shall be punished by a fine of ten dollars and costs of prose-
5 cution for each offence.
