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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT requiring all Educational Institutions receiving  
State Aid to make report to the State Superintendent of  
Public Schools, who shall publish the same as a part of his  
Annual Report.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Every educational institution receiving State  
2 aid, shall report to the State superintendent of public schools,  
3 the total and average attendance, receipts and expenditures,  
4 number of instructors, number and length of terms, with  
5 attendance for each and answer such other questions as he

6 shall determine, and the same shall be published in his  
7 annual report.

Sect. 2. Every such educational institution failing to  
2 comply with the above requirements shall forfeit whatever aid  
3 or assistance, it would otherwise receive from the State.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith  
2 are hereby repealed.
