STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT additional to Section 104, Chapter 11 of the Revised
Statutes of 1883, as now amended, relating to the Duties of
the State Superintendent of Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 104 of chapter 11 of the Revised
2 Statutes, is amended by adding thereto paragraph XI, which
3 said paragraph shall read as follows:

‘Paragraph XI. The State superintendent shall furnish
5 to the school officers of each town, proper blank books in
6 which shall be kept complete and itemized records of all
7 matters relating to moneys appropriated, received and

8 expended for schools, which said books shall remain the
9 property of the State.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
