STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend Section 8, Chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes of 1883, as now amended, relating to Text-books, School Apparatus and repairs on School Buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 8 of chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes,
- 2 as amended by chapter 268 of the Public Laws of 1889, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "books" in the
- 4 first line the words 'apparatus and appliances' and is further
- 5 amended by inserting after the word "schools" in the second
- 6 line the words 'including all free high schools,' also by
- 7 striking out the words "and all" in the third line and insert-

8 ing in place thereof the words 'and shall also pay for the 9 necessary repairs of school buildings and insurance on 10 same, if any, improvement and maintenance of school yards 11 and play grounds out of a sum or sums of,' and also by 12 inserting the word 'which' after the word "purpose" in the 13 fourth line thereof, so that said section as amended shall 14 read as follows:

'Section 8. Towns shall provide school books, apparatus and appliances for the use of the pupils in the public schools, including all free high schools, at the expense of said town; and shall also pay for the necessary repairs of school buildings and insurance on same, if any, improvement and mainto tenance of school yards and play grounds out of a sum or sums of money raised and appropriated for that purpose which shall be assessed like other moneys; provided, however, that any parent or guardian of any pupil in the public schools may, at his own expense, procure for the separate and exclusive use of such pupil, the text books required to be used in such schools.'

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
