STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in relation to the care of Convicts who are Sick at
the Expiration of Sentence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whenever a convict, at the expiration of his
2 sentence, is sick and unable to be removed from jail, he
3 shall be cared for by the jailer, at the expense of the county,
4 until the county commissioners deem it safe for him to be
5 removed.
