STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT authorizing the town of Wayne to raise money to
be expended in Celebrating the One Hundredth Anniver-
sary of its Incorporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Wayne in the
2 county of Kennebec are hereby authorized and empowered
3 to raise by taxation, in the same manner in which other
4 sums of money are now raised by taxation, a sum of money
5 not to exceed five hundred dollars, in the year one thousand
6 eight hundred ninety-seven, to be expended in celebrating
7 the one hundredth anniversary of the incorporation of said
8 town.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
