AN ACT to amend section one hundred and twelve of chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter thirty-seven of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one and by chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, relating to Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School.

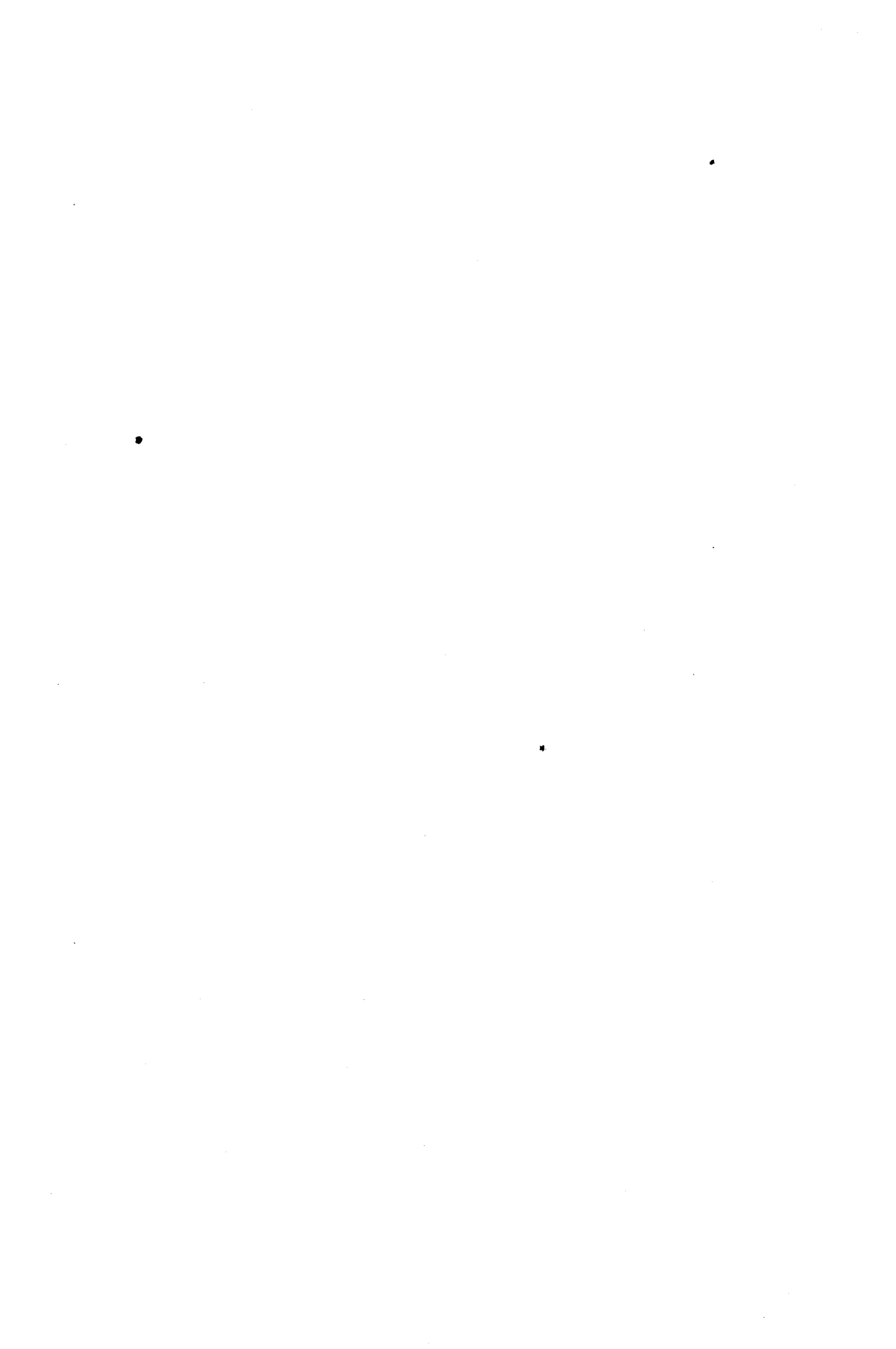
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one hundred twelve of chapter eleven
2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter thirty-seven
3 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one and
4 by chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the Public Laws

5 of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, is hereby amended by
6 inserting in place of the words "twenty-seven" in the sec-
7 one line thereof, the words 'thirty-one,' so that said section
8 shall read as follows:

'Section 112. For the support of the three normal schools
10 and the Madawaska Training School, thirty-one thousand
11 dollars is annually appropriated, to be expended under the
12 direction of said trustees, which sum the treasurer of State
13 shall deduct for said purpose from any school money raised
14 for the support of common schools. The Governor and
15 Council may from time to time, as they think proper, draw
16 warrants therefor on said treasurer in favor of said trustees.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
