STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize the Maine Pulp and Paper Company to
generate, sell, supply, distribute and transmit electricity for
power and heating. .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Maine Pulp and Paper Company, a cor-
2 poration organized under the laws of the State of Maine, and
3 located in Lewiston, county of Androscoggin and State of
4 Maine, its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right
5 to generate, sell, supply, distribute and transmit electricity
6 for power and heating in the cities of Lewiston and Auburn
7 and the towns of Greene and Turner in the said county of
8 Androscoggin, but not to include electricity for electric

9 lighting for municipal or private purposes, without the con-
10 sent of all companies, firms or corporations now furnishing
11 electric lights for municipal or private purposes in said Lew-
12 iston and Auburn, except that said Maine Pulp and Paper
13 Company may furnish power to any company, firm or cor-
14 poration, which is now engaged in the distribution and sale
15 of electric power for municipal or private lighting in said
16 cities of Lewiston and Auburn.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
