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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT relating to and amendatory of Chapter 213, Special  
Laws of 1891, entitled An Act to incorporate the York Light  
and Heat Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The York Light and Heat Company is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to take up, cancel and retire its  
3 bonds already issued and the mortgage securing the same,  
4 and for that purpose may issue bonds for the payment of,  
5 or the refunding of its indebtedness, also for the further  
6 construction of its works, for such an amount, and upon  
7 such rate and time as it may deem expedient and necessary,  
8 not to exceed the sum of fifty thousand dollars, (\$50,000) in

9 addition to the amount of its present bonded indebtedness,  
10 and may secure the same by a mortgage or deed of trust of  
11 its franchise, or franchises, property and estate owned by or  
12 to be hereafter acquired by said corporation, but said mort-  
13 gage shall not diminish the security of its bonds, heretofore  
14 issued by said corporation remaining unpaid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
