IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in relation to Suits for Taxes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The State treasurer in the name of the State,  
2 and the assessors of cities, towns and plantations in the name  
3 of the city, town or plantation, may bring an action of debt  
4 within two years from the date of assessment, to collect  
5 unpaid taxes with interest and charges thereon, in accord-  
6 ance with the provisions of sections seven and eight of chap-  
7 ter sixty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and  
8 ninety-five. The deed given under section seven to be  
9 deposited with the State treasurer in case of suits by the  
10 State, and in other cases with the treasurer of the city, town  
11 or plantation bringing the suit.
