STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Topsfield.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Topsfield
2 the sum of twenty-one dollars and eighty-seven cents,
3 (\$21.87) out of the common school fund of 1897, on account
4 of an error made in returning the number of scholars from
5 that town for the year 1896.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Nine scholars from Kossuth, an adjoining township, attended school in town of Topsfield under the law of 1895, chapter 116. In making their return to the State superintendent of schools they were not enumerated with the scholars returned in the town. The returns now in the superintendent of schools' office show this to be correct.
