STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to Chapter 320 of the Private and Special
Laws of 1895, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kennebago
Railroad Company."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All the provisions of chapter 320 of the private
2 and special laws of 1895, relating to the incorporation of the
3 Kennebago Railroad Company are hereby extended for and
4 during the term of two years from January first, eighteen
5 hundred and ninety-seven; and said company is hereby
6 authorized to organize and commence the construction of
7 its railroad at any time during that term, subject to all the
8 conditions and provisions named in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
