STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter three hundred and ninety-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, as amended by chapter 204 of the Private and Special Laws of 1895, relating to the Charter of the Deer Isle Telephone Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section eight of chapter three hundred and
2 ninety-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and ninety-three, as amended by chapter two hundred
4 and four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
5 dred and ninety-five is hereby further amended by striking
6 out the word "four" in the second line of said section, and

7 inserting in its place the word 'six,' so that said section as
8 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 8. This charter shall be null and void unless
10 operations shall actually commence hereunder within six
11 years from the date of the passage of this act.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
