STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and fifty-three of
the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-
nine, relating to the Bluehill Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter three hundred and
2 fifty-three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and eighty-nine is hereby amended by inserting after
4 the name "David W. Bunker" in the third line of said sec-
5 tion, the name 'George H. Stover,' so that said section as
6 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Edward E. Chase, Nahum Hinckley, Arthur
8 C. Hinckley, Frank P. Merrill, Rufus P. Grindle, David

9 W. Bunker, George H. Stover and Augustus N. Osgood,
10 their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incor-
11 porated by the name of Bluehill Water Company, for the
12 purpose of supplying the inhabitants of the town of Blue-
13 hill with pure water for domestic, sanitary and municipal
14 purposes, including the extinguishment of fires.’

Sect. 2. All the rights, powers and privileges of the Blue-
2 hill Water Company which were granted by said chapter
3 three hundred and fifty-three of the Private and Special
4 Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine are hereby
5 extended for two years additional.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
