STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and eighty-four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninetyfive, entitled An Act to incorporate the Castine Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of chapter one hundred and 2 eighty-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hun-3 dred and ninety-five is hereby amended by adding to said 4 section the following words: Nor upon the observatory lot 5 near the highest point of the peninsular of Castine, bounded

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6 northeasterly by the private way which enters High street 7 between land of Arthur Fuller and the late W. C. Collins, 8 southeasterly by the land formerly kuown as the Back Point 9 pasture, northwesterly by the private way leading from the 10 first named way to the private way adjoining said Back 11 Point pasture, and southeasterly by the land formerly known 12 as Perkins front pasture, and by the land to be conveyed to 13 said Castine Water Company,' so that said section, as 14 amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 4. When said company shall have occasion to 16 take, detain, divert, or use any waters as aforesaid, or take 17 and use any lands as aforesaid, it shall cause a statement of 18 such waters, and a description of such lands, with a plan 19 thereof, and a statement of the amount of damages it is wil-20 ling to pay each person for the property so taken or used, 21 to be filed in the registry of deeds for Hancock county, and 22 also in the office of town clerk of Castine, and public notices, 23 announcing that said filing has been made, shall be con-24 spicuously posted in said town of Castine, at the same date, 25 and within ten days of such filing a copy of such statement 26 and description shall be published three weeks successively 27 in some newspaper in said Castine or Ellsworth in said 28 county. Such water or land shall be deemed to have been 29 taken at the date of such filing. The corporation shall 30 occupy no water or lands until the expiration of ten days 31 from the date of said filing, but may make all needful sur-32 face explorations, and surveys, and levels, on any lands or 33 waters in said Castine, prior to such filing. The corpora34 tion shall not take, nor in any manner encroach upon the 35 land known as Fort George in said Castine, nor the land 36 immediately surrounding it, bounded southwesterly by land 37 occupied by Charles F. Bates, and on the other three sides 38 by town ways, nor upon the observatory lot near the highest 39 point of the peninsular of Castine, bounded northeasterly by 40 the private way which enters High street between land of 41 Arthur Fuller and the late W. C. Collins, southeasterly by 42 the land formerly known as the Back Point pasture, north-43 westerly by the private way leading from the first named way 44 to the private way adjoining said Back Point pasture, and 45 southeasterly by the land formerly known as Perkins front 46 pasture, and by the land to be conveyed to said Castine 47 Water Company.'
