IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter two hundred and forty-six of the
Private and Special Laws of Eighteen hundred and Ninety-
five, entitled "An Act to prevent the use of narrow rimmed
wheels on Greenfield road in town of Greenbush."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-six of the
2 private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five
3 is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
