STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section sixty-seven of chapter eighty-one of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and seven of the Public Laws of 1895, relating to Attachments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section sixty-seven of chapter eighty-one of the Revised 2 Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and seven of 3 the Public Laws of 1895, is hereby amended by striking

- 4 out after the word situated in the thirteenth line of said
- 5 laws the words "subject to the exceptions named in this sec-
- 6 tion" and also by striking out after the word attachments
- 7 in the sixteenth line of said laws the words "in which case

8 the time shall be extended for a further period of five years,"
9 and inserting in place thereof the words 'and at the expira10 tion of five years from the time of such first, or any subse11 quent bringing forward, such attachment shall expire,
12 unless within said period, it is again brought forward in
13 like manner,' so that said section as amended shall read
14 as follows:

'Section 67. An attachment of real or personal estate 16 continues for thirty days, and no longer, after final judg-17 ment in the original suit, and not in review or error; except 18 attachments of equities of redeeming real estate mortgaged 19 or taken on execution; or equities of redemption sold on 20 execution; or an obligee's conditional right to a conveyance 21 of real estate on execution; or property attached and 22 replevied; or property attached belonging to a person dying 23 thereafter, or specially provided for in any other case; but 24 an attachment of real estate shall expire at the end of five 25 years from the date of filing the same in the office of the 26 register of deeds in the county or district where the said 27 real estate or some part of it is situated, unless the said 28 register shall, within said period, at the request of the plain-29 tiff or his attorney bring forward the same upon the book 30 of attachments, and at the expiration of five years from the 31 time of such first, or any subsequent bringing forward, such 32 attachment shall expire unless within said period it is again 33 brought forward in like manner. The register shall be 34 entitled to the same fee for bringing forward such attach35 ment upon the said book of attachments, as for the orig-36 inal entry thereof.'
