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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT additional to the Charter of the Portsmouth, Kittery and York Street Railway.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Portsmouth, Kittery and York Street  
2 Railway is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a  
3 bridge so as not to unnecessarily obstruct navigation, for  
4 the passage of its cars and for teams or carriages, across  
5 the tide-waters of the Piscataqua river in said Kittery from  
6 the mainland at or near the foot of Newmarch street in said  
7 Kittery, to Badger's Island.

Sect. 2. Said company is further authorized to construct and maintain a railroad bridge so as not to unnecessarily obstruct navigation for the passage of its cars across the tide-waters of Brave Boat Harbor, between the towns of Kittery and York, between such points as may be found convenient.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
