STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company, and enable it to cross navigable tide waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The creation and organization of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company is hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and valid, and all the provisions of chapter 477 of the Private and Special Laws of 1893, and of chapter 110 of the Private and Special Laws of 1895, relative to the incorporation of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company and all the limitations therein contained are hereby extended for and

9 during the additional period of two years from March 9,
10 1897, and said corporation, its successors and assigns,
11 shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were
12 granted by said acts, to be exercised in the same manner
13 and for the same purposes as provided in this act. Said
14 corporation shall be liable for any damages to water and
15 gas pipes caused by the action of the electric current
16 used by it.
