RESOLVE providing for the expenses of the Governor and Staff while attending the ceremonies relating to the formal transfer of the Grant Monument to the city of New York.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be and

3 be needed, to be used in defraying the expenses of the gov-
4 ernor and his military staff while attending the ceremonies
5 relating to the formal transfer of the Grant monument to
6 the city of New York, by the Grant Monument Associa-
7 tion, in the city of New York, April twenty-seventh,
8 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
