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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to incorporate the Town of Perham.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Township number fourteen, range four,  
2 west from the east line of the State, in the county of  
3 Aroostook, and known as Perham plantation, is hereby  
4 incorporated into a town by the name of Perham, and  
5 the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested with all  
6 the powers, privileges, immunities and liabilities of other  
7 towns.

Sect. 2. Any justice of the peace within the county of  
2 Aroostook is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to  
3 some inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the  
4 inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he

5 shall appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are  
6 empowered to choose at their annual town meeting.

Sect. 3. The town hereby created shall take the effects  
2 belonging to Perham plantation, and shall also assume all  
3 the obligations of said plantation.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
