AN ACT to permit the Patten and Sherman Railroad Com-  
pany to sell or lease its road.

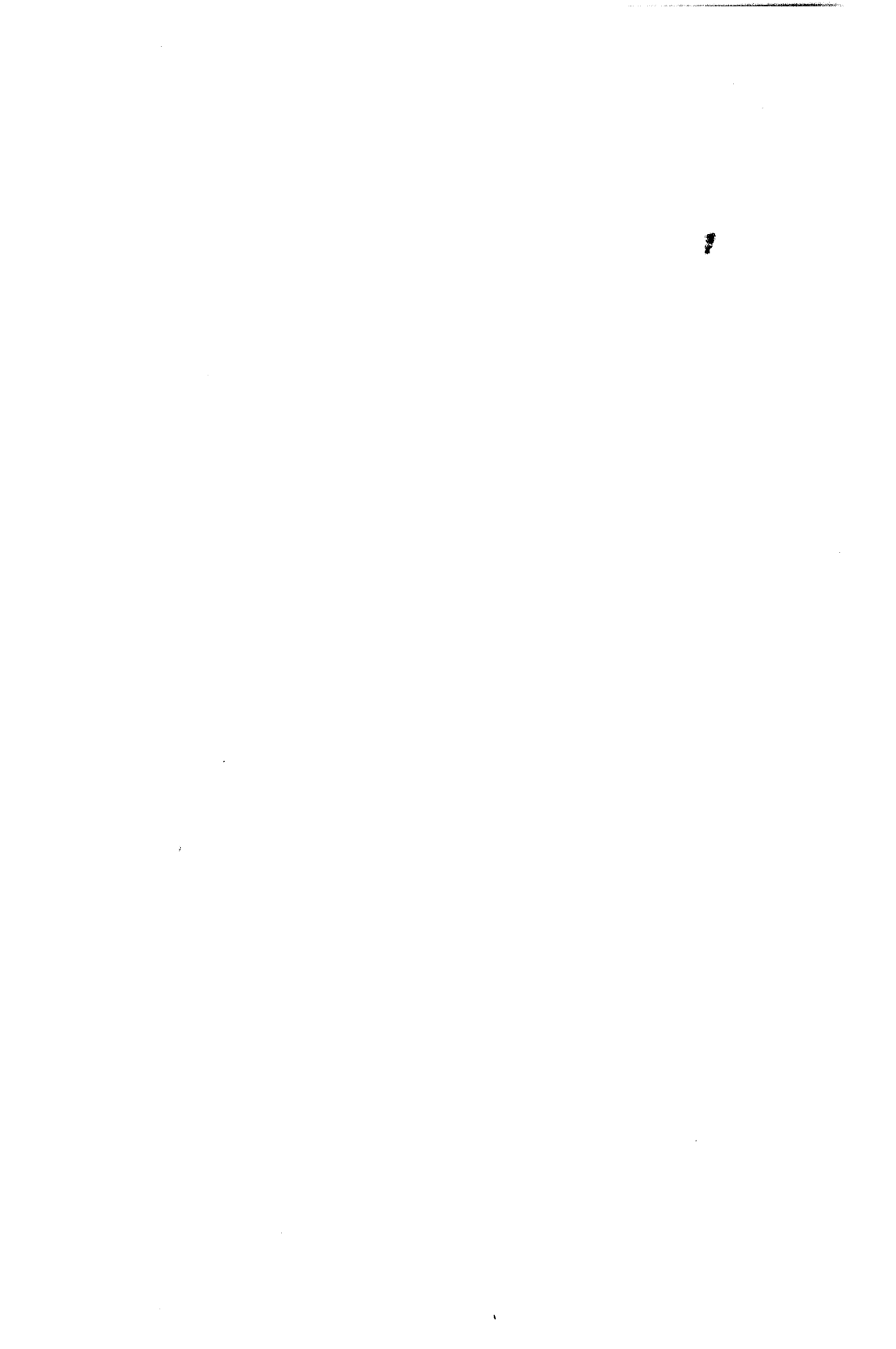

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Patten and Sherman Railroad Company  
2 is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, lease or  
3 mortgage its line and all its improvements to any person  
4 or persons, or any other railroad corporation, which  
5 person or persons, or which latter corporation is hereby  
6 authorized to enter into such contract of sale, lease or  
7 mortgage, and the directors of the two corporations may  
8 enter into such contracts for the running of the road, and  
9 for the purchase, sale, lease or mortgage thereof, as the

10 directors of the two companies in the exercise of their  
11 best judgment and discretion may deem for the advantage  
12 of their respective corporations.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
