STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT authorizing the construction of a townway or highway over and across the tide waters of Webhanet river in Wells.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. A townway or a highway may be laid out, 2 constructed and maintained in the manner provided in 3 chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes, across the tide 4 waters of the Webhanet river in the town of Wells in the 5 county of York, with a suitable draw-bridge over said 6 tide waters ; said draw-bridge to be built at some suitable

7 and convenient point between the mouth of said Web-
8 hanet river and the "Island Ledge Bridge" so called.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
