STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize the Brewer Light and Power Company
of Brewer, Maine, to transact Business within the City of
Brewer.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization of the Brewer Light and
2 Power Company, a corporation organized under the general
3 laws of the State of Maine, the certificate of organization
4 of which corporation was filed in the office of the secretary
5 of State on the twenty-second day of December, eighteen
6 hundred and ninety-six, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to make,
2 generate, sell, distribute and supply electricity for lighting,

3 heating, manufacturing and mechanical purposes in said
4 city of Brewer, and to purchase, hold and convey such
5 real estate and personal property as shall be necessary for
6 all said purposes, and do all things necessary for the con-
7 structing, carrying on, enlarging and extending the busi-
8 ness of making, generating, selling, distributing and sup-
9 plying electricity for lighting, heating, manufacturing and
10 mechanical purposes, within the limits of said city of Brewer.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
