IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend Clause twenty-six of Section six of Chapter one of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter one hundred and forty-one of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, relating to Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Clause twenty-six of section six of chapter one 2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred 3 and forty-one of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and 4 ninety-five, is hereby amended by striking out the word 5 "three" in the tenth line and inserting in place thereof the 6 word 'two,' so that said clause shall read as follows:

'XXVI. Acts of incorporation shall be regarded in legal 8 proceedings as public acts, and be in force of the date of 9 their approval. All acts of incorporation granted since 10 January one, eighteen hundred and ninety-three, become 11 null and void in two years from the day when the same take 12 effect, unless such corporations shall have organized and 13 commenced actual business under their charters. The 14 organization of any corporation which may be hereafter 15 organized under any general law of this State becomes null 16 and void within two years from the day when its certificate 17 of incorporation has been filed in the office of the secretary 18 of State, unless such corporation shall have commenced 19 actual business under its organization.'
