STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to legalize the doings of the Saccarappa Aqueduct
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The acts and doings of the Saccarappa Aqueduct Company, which was organized under the statutes of the State, on the sixth day of June eighteen hundred and forty-six, for the purpose of supplying water to the inhabitants of Saccarappa, in the present city of Westbrook, in laying assessments, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, upon the shares of stockholders to defray the expense of repairing its mains, and subsequently sell-

9 ing the shares of delinquents for non-payment of such
10 assessments, are hereby legalized and declared valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
