STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section seven of Chapter 180, Private and
Special Laws of 1869, relating to organization of the
Protestant Episcopal Church of Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section seven of chapter one hundred and
2 eighty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
3 and sixty-nine is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

‘Section 7. The annual meeting shall take place at such
5 time as may have been agreed upon in the first week in
6 Advent, and at such annual meeting an election of the
7 requisite number of wardens and vestry-men shall be had,
8 to serve until the next annual meeting, and until their suc-
9 cessors shall be chosen.’
