STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section five of Chapter 22 of the Public
Laws of 1887, as amended by Chapter 206 of the Public Laws
of 1893, relating to the filling of vacancies in the office of
Truant Officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section five of chapter 22 of the Public Laws
2 of 1887 as amended by chapter 206 of the Public Laws of
3 1893, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
4 words:

‘Superintending school committees shall have power to
6 fill vacancies occurring during the year.’

So that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘The municipal officers shall fix the compensation of the
9 truant officers elected as prescribed in section three. The
10 superintending school committee shall have power to fill
11 vacancies occurring during the year.’
