## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for State pensions for invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows and orphans, and the dependent children, parents and sisters of deceased soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under existing law.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars be  
2 and is hereby appropriated to provide for State pensions  
3 for invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows and orphans,  
4 and the dependent children, parents and sisters of deceased  
5 soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under existing law, for  
6 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and seventy-  
7 five thousand dollars for the year eighteen hundred and  
8 ninety-eight.
