IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in Relation to the Bonds of Trustees and Guardians.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whenever a trustee or guardian settles an  
2 account in probate court, the judge of probate shall examine  
3 his bond, and shall endorse thereon the fact that such exam-  
4 ination has been made. If he finds the bond insufficient  
5 in amount, or the sureties unsatisfactory, he shall require  
6 a new bond, in such amount and with such sureties as he  
7 may approve, and such trustee or guardian, failing to give  
8 such new bond, shall be removed.
