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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to empower the Portland Elevator Company to lay  
a railroad track, lease its franchise and other purposes.

Section I. In addition to the powers conferred upon the

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

2 Portland Elevator Company by its organization, said com-  
3 pany is hereby authorized to lay and maintain over its own  
4 premises such track or tracks as may be necessary to connect  
5 its elevator and storehouses with the tracks used by the  
6 Grand Trunk Railway Company of Canada for the purposes  
7 of storing and shipping grain, and said Portland Elevator  
8 Company is further authorized and empowered to give, and  
9 the Grand Trunk Railway Company of Canada to receive, a

10 lease of the franchises, elevator, power house, storehouses,  
11 railroad tracks of said Portland Elevator Company and all  
12 other property connected therewith upon such terms, condi-  
13 tions, agreements and rentals as the Portland Elevator  
14 Company and the Grand Trunk Railway Company of  
15 Canada shall agree upon. The coupon bonds of said Port-  
16 land Elevator Company, dated January 1, A. D. 1897, to the  
17 amount of two hundred thousand dollars, the indenture of  
18 trust and mortgage securing the payment of the same and  
19 the agreements, conveyances and acts of said company  
20 connected with the issue thereof are hereby authorized and  
21 made valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
