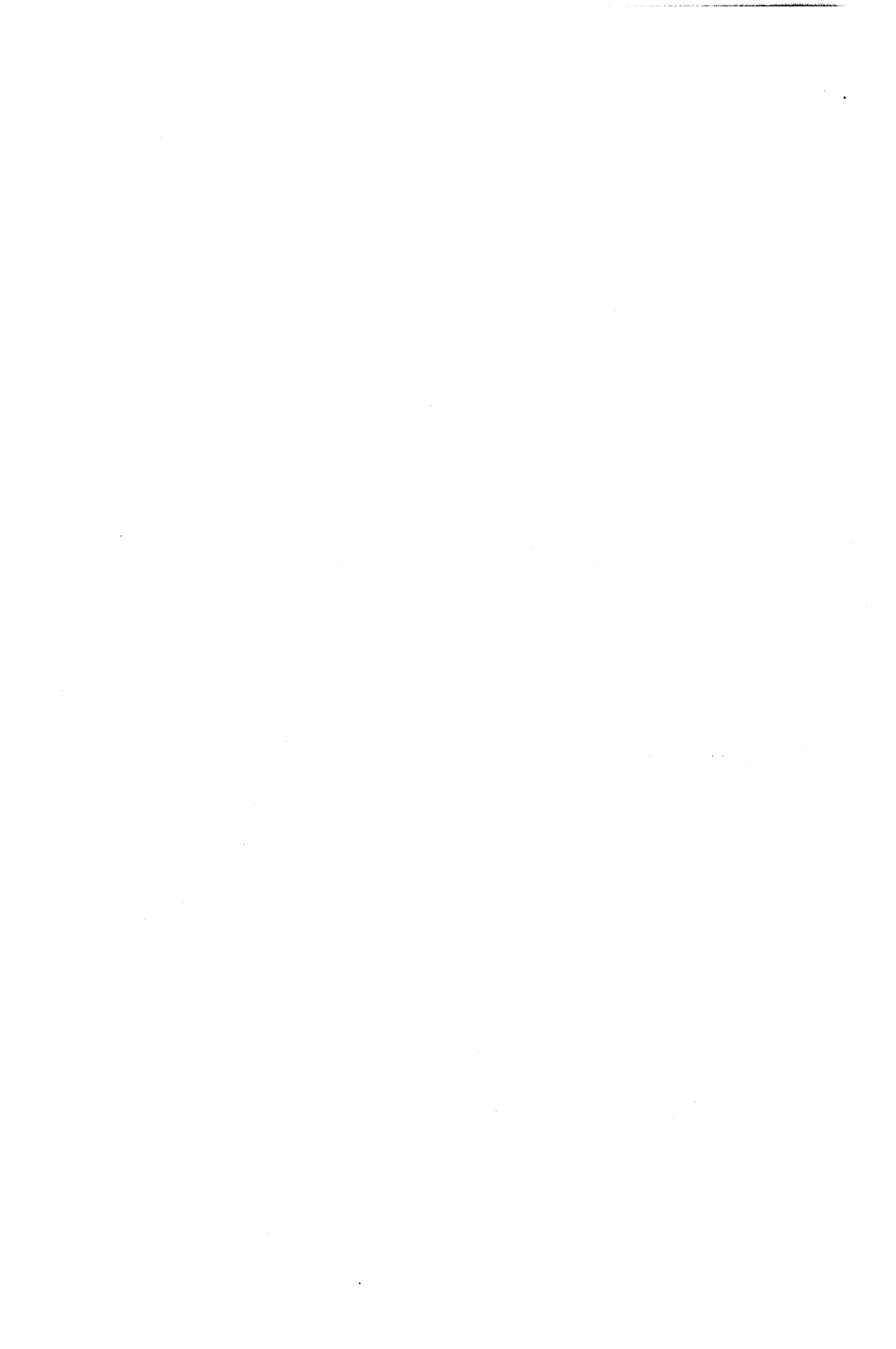
AN ACT to legalize the lease of the Old Town Street Railway
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The lease heretofore made by the Old Town
2 Street Railway Company to the Bangor, Orono and Old
3 Town Railway Company, under the provisions of section
4 thirteen of chapter four hundred ninety-five of the Private
5 and Special Laws, for the year one thousand eight hundred
6 and eighty-nine, is hereby confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The franchises heretofore granted to said Old
2 Town Street Railway Company are hereby renewed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
