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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in relation to the claim of the State of Maine for indemnity for expenses incurred by it in defence of the United States.

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*Resolved:* That the action of the governor council in ap-  
2 pointing agents and attorneys for and on behalf of the State  
3 to prosecute its claim against the Government of the United  
4 States for reimbursement under the provisions of the act of  
5 July 27th, 1861, chapter 21, volume 12, statutes at large of  
6 the United States, entitled: "An Act to indemnify the State  
7 for expenses incurred by them in defence of the United  
8 States," be and hereby is ratified and confirmed; that the  
9 governor and council are hereby authorized and empowered  
10 to make a contract with such agents and attorneys for their  
11 compensation for services and disbursements in the prose-

12 cution of said claim; and that the governor and council are  
13 hereby authorized and empowered to make payment to said  
14 agents and attorneys for services and disbursements in ac-  
15 cordance with such contract from any moneys recovered by  
16 the State from said claims.
