
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to correct a Clerical Error in Chapter sixty-one of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one relating to Migratory Fish.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The word "weirs," in the fourth line in section 2 seventeen of chapter forty of the Revised Statutes as 3 ammended by chapter sixty-one of the Public Laws of 4 eighteen hundred and ninety-one, is hereby stricken out

5 and the word 'rivers,' be inserted in lieu thereof.
