STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend Private and Special Laws of 1893, relat-
ing to Glidden Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 607 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1893 is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word "of," in the second line, the word 'little,' so that
4 said section as amended shall read as follows: 'Section 3.
5 Said corporation is hereby authorized, for the purposes
6 aforesaid, to take, detain and use the water of Little, Pema-
7 quid or Damariscotta pond, in Lincoln county, and to erect
8 and maintain reservoirs and dams, and lay down and main-
9 tain pipes and aqueducts necessary for the proper accumu-

10 lating, conducting, discharging, distributing and disposing
11 of water, and forming proper reservoirs thereof; and said
12 corporation may take and hold, by purchase or otherwise,
13 any lands or real estate necessary therefor, and may exca-
14 vate through any lands when necessary for the purposes of
15 the corporation.'
