STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize the United Gas and Electric Company
of New Hampshire to hold Property and do Business in
Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The United Gas and Electric Company, a cor-
2 poration organized under the laws of the State of New
3 Hampshire, is hereby authorized to purchase, hold, main-
4 tain and operate the property of the Consolidated Light and
5 Power Company incorporated by act approved the twenty-
6 first day of March, A. D. 1893, situate in this State and,
7 upon such purchase, is hereby invested with all the rights
8 and powers granted to said Consolidated Light and Power

9 Company by said act subject to the limitations and condi-
10 tions imposed therein; and said United Gas and Electric
11 Company may mortgage its property in this State, includ-
12 ing its franchise, with its other property, to secure bonds
13 to be issued by it, not exceeding in amount the amount of
14 its capital stock subscribed for.

Sect. 2. This act takes effect when approved.
