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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to extend the charter of the Castine Railway and  
Navigation Company, and to amend its charter and certain  
additions thereto.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Castine Railway and Navigation Com-  
2 pany is hereby granted an extension of two years from and  
3 after the approval of this act in which to avail itself of the  
4 rights, powers, privileges and immunities heretofore granted  
5 to said company by the legislature.

Sect. 2. Section 1 of chapter 138 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1887, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the  
3 Castine and Bangor Railroad Company," is hereby amended

4 by inserting after the word "Castine," in the fourth line of  
5 the last sentence of said section, the words 'and Brooksville.'

Sect. 3. Said chapter 138 is hereby amended by striking  
2 out all of section 15.

Sect. 4. Section 3 of chapter 543 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1889, is hereby amended by adding to said  
3 section the following words, 'and the towns of Bluehill and  
4 Surry, and the city of Ellsworth.'

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
