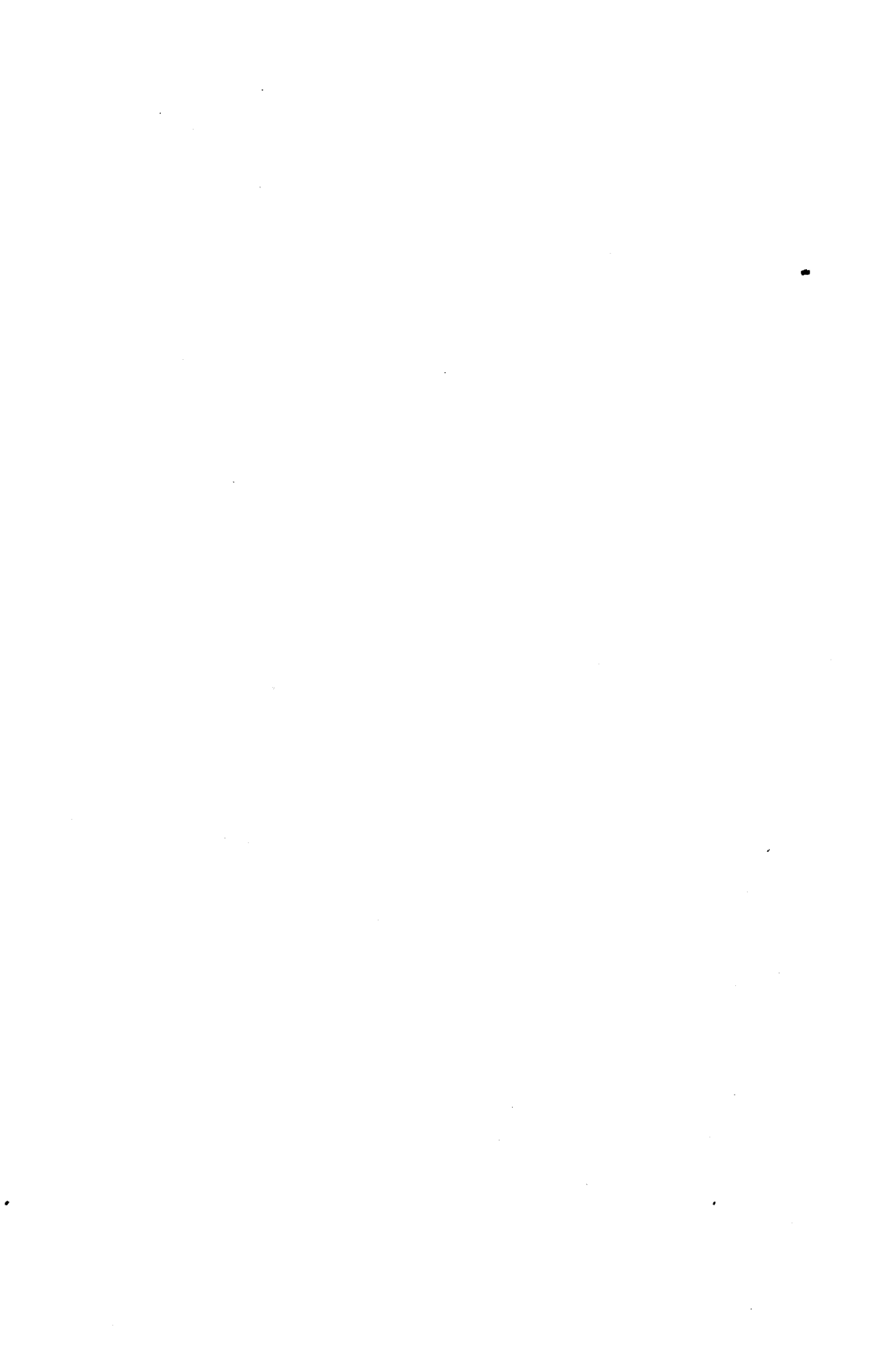

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Aid in Building Bridge across Sandy
stream in Lexington Plantation.

Resolved, That one hundred and fifty dollars is hereby
2 appropriated out of any money in the treasury of the State
3 to assist in building a bridge over Sandy stream, so called,
4 in Lexington Plantation, and when said bridge is com-
5 pleted to the satisfaction of the county commissioners of
6 Somerset county, and they so return, the governor shall
7 draw his warrant from the above amount to the treasurer
8 of Somerset county.
