STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 207 of the Public Laws
of 1889, relating to Clerk of Judicial Courts, in Piscataquis
county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1, of chapter 207 of the Public Laws of 1889, is
2 hereby amended by striking out, after the word quarterly,
3 in the fourth line thereof, all of the remaining words of said
4 section, and substituting therefor, the words, "on the last
5 days of March, June, September, and December, and all
6 fees of his office as established by law," so that said section
7 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The clerk of the judicial courts of the county
9 of Piscataquis, shall hereafter receive an annual compensa-

10 tion of seven hundred dollars, to be paid out of the county
11 treasury of said county, quarterly on the last days of March,
12 June, September, and December, and all fees of his office
13 as established by law.'
