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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT authorizing the construction of a Wharf into the  
tide waters of Casco Bay and Bridges over tide water, in  
the Town of Harpswell.

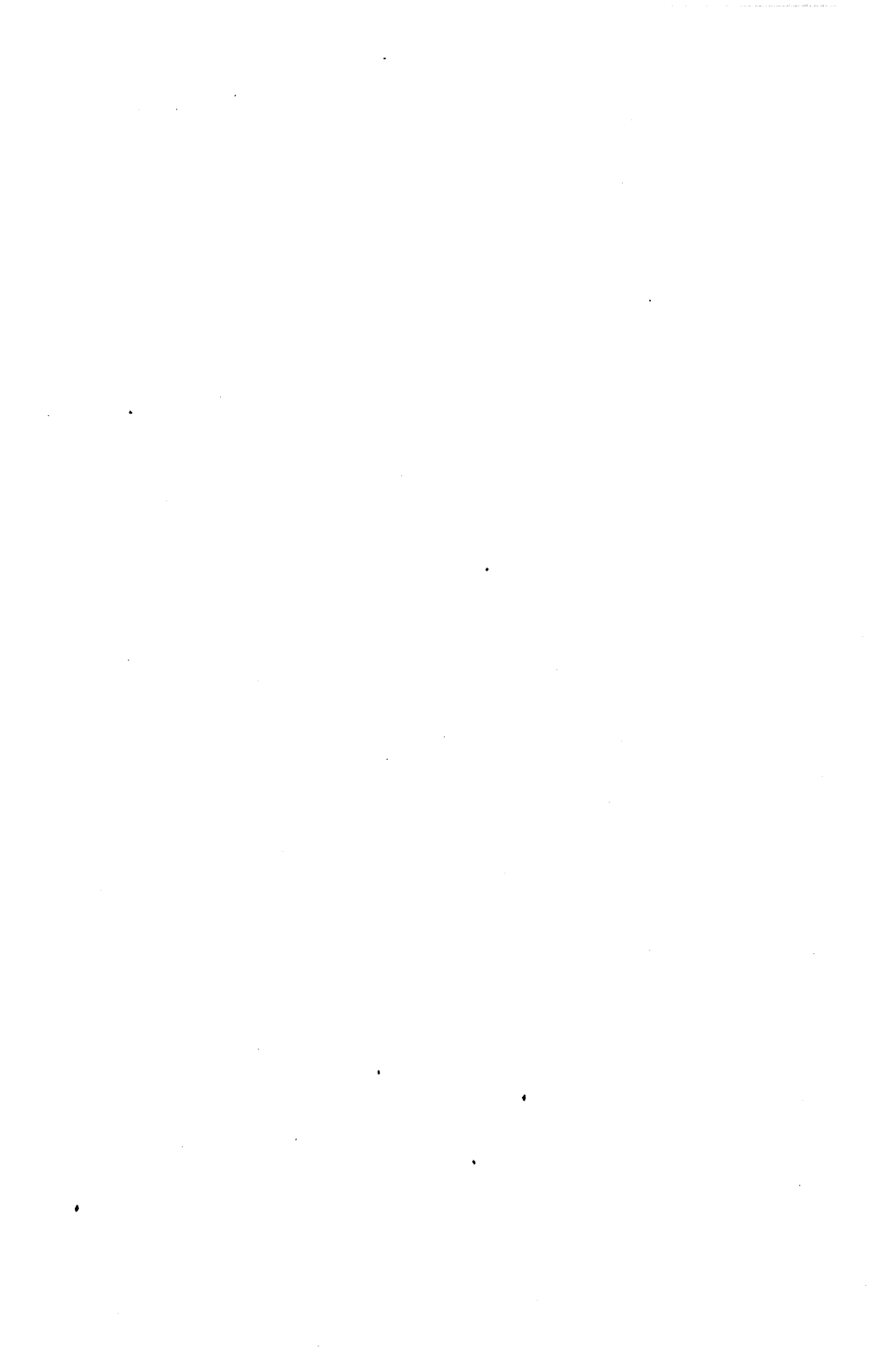
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Benjamin Thompson and his assigns, as the  
2 owners of Little Whaleboat Island, situated in the town of  
3 Harpswell, in the county of Cumberland, are hereby author-  
4 ized to erect and maintain in the tide waters of Casco bay,  
5 a wharf off the northerly end of said island, suitable for the  
6 landing of steamers and to erect and maintain bridges from  
7 the large island to the small islands on the easterly and  
8 westerly sides thereof.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
