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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to authorize the Maine Central Railroad Company,  
its successors and assigns, to construct and maintain a wharf  
and boat house in Lake Maranacook in the towns of Read-  
field and Winthrop.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Maine Central Railroad Company, a cor-  
2 poration established by law, its successors and assigns, are  
3 hereby authorized and empowered to construct, maintain  
4 and control a wharf extending into the waters of Lake  
5 Maranacook, in the towns of Readfield and Winthrop, not  
6 exceeding seventy-five (75) feet, and extending southerly  
7 twelve hundred (1200) feet from the face of the abutment of  
8 said railroad company's railroad bridge on the westerly

9 shore of said Lake Maranacook, and along the shore by  
10 land leased by said railroad company of Mark A. Collins for  
11 excursion purposes; and to construct, maintain and control  
12 a boat-house over or in said waters, of such dimensions as  
13 it shall deem proper.

Sect. 2. This act shall not be construed to prevent per-  
2 sons or boats from going to said wharf and moorings, and  
3 landings, who do not solicit or receive people or passengers  
4 at said wharf who have been transported by the Maine  
5 Central Railroad Company as excursionists to said wharf  
6 and excursion grounds as specially advertised excursionists.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
