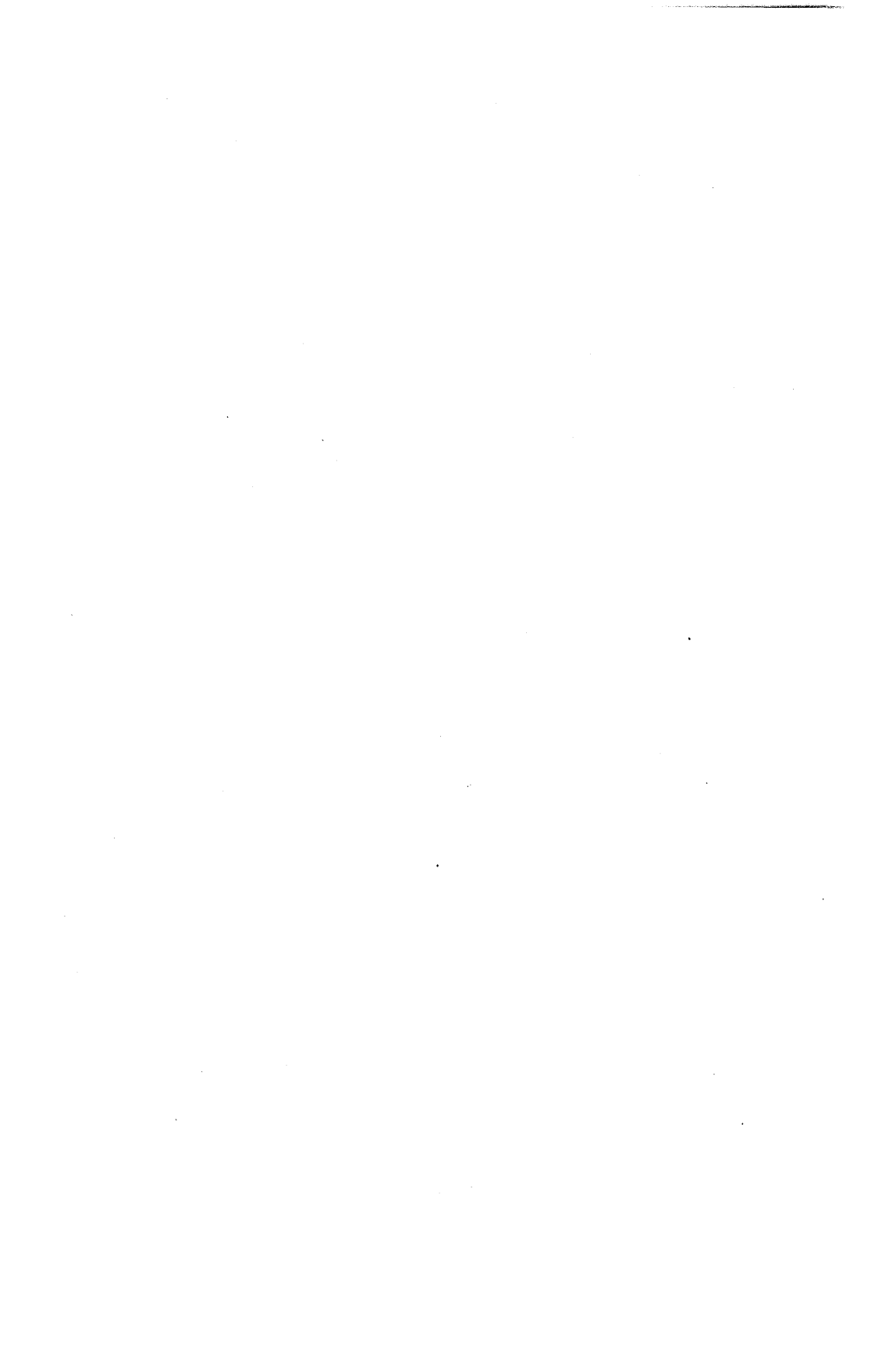

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in relation to suits by organized unincorporated
Societies and Associations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Any organized, unincorporated society or
2 association, may sue in the name of its trustees for the time
3 being, and may maintain an action at law, through the
4 defendant or defendants or some of them are members of the
5 same society or association.
