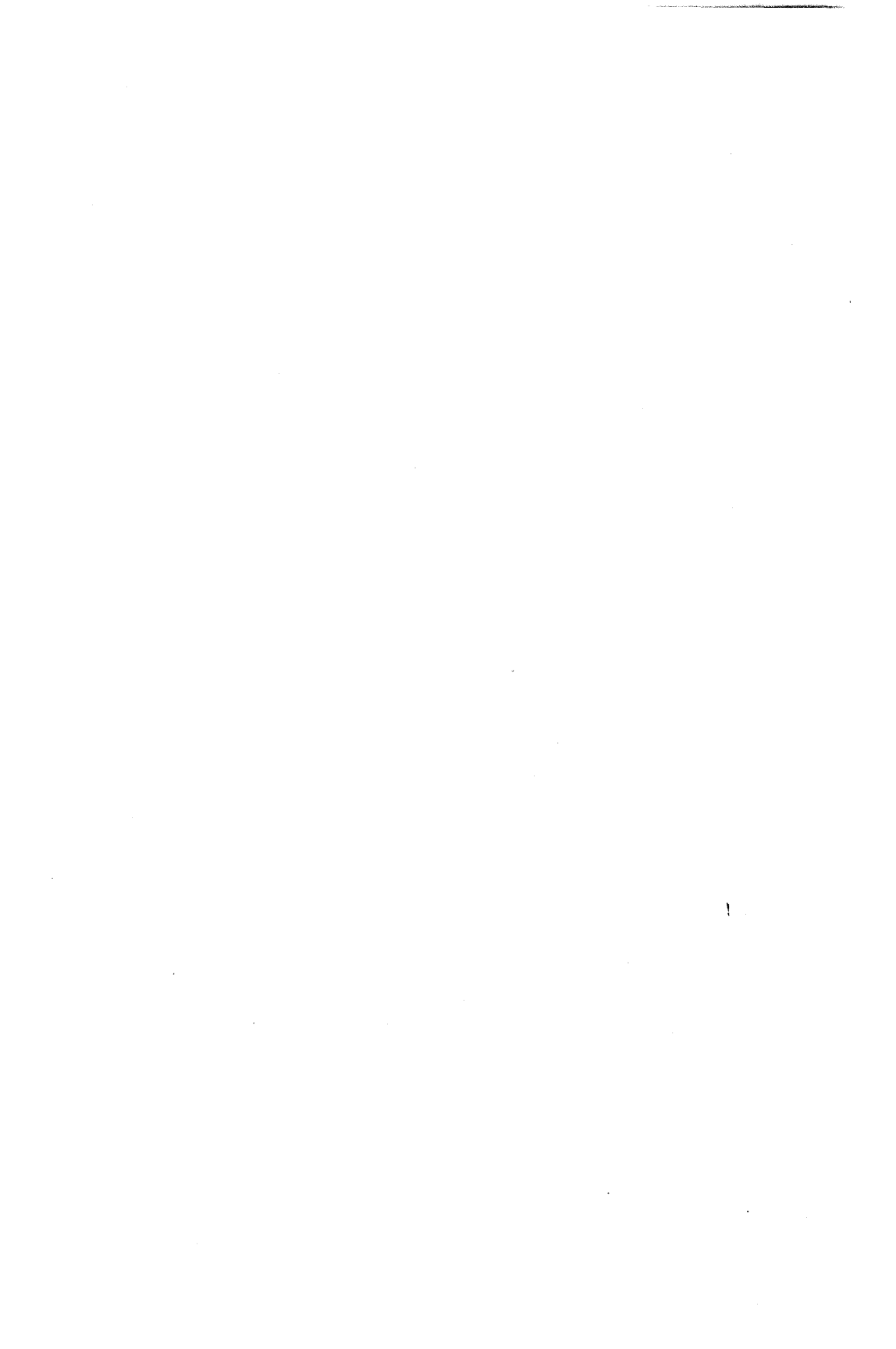
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in addition to Chapter fifty-five of the Revised
Statutes relating to the incorporation of Libraries, Charitable
Societies, and other like corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The president, treasurer and majority of the directors
2 or trustees of every corporation hereafter organized under
3 the provisions of chapter fifty-five of the Revised Statutes
4 shall, within sixty days after organization, prepare a certifi-
5 cate setting forth the name and purposes of the corporation,
6 the town where located, the number and names of the offi-
7 cers, and shall sign and make oath to it, and shall file the
8 same in the office of the secretary of State.
