STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and ninety-four of chapter six of Revised Statutes, as amended by section three of chapter seventy of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five relating to the sale of real estate for taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one hundred and ninety-four of chap-2 ter six of Revised Statutes, as amended by section three of
- 3 chapter seventy of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred
- 4 and ninety-five is hereby amended by adding thereto after
- 5 the word "dollar" in the last line thereof the words 'in addi-
- 6 tion to the sum paid to the printer, if any' so that said sec-
- 7 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 194. After the land is so advertised, and at least 9 ten days before the day of sale, the collector shall notify the 10 owner, if resident, or the occupant thereof, if any, of the 11 time and place of sale by delivering to him in person, or 12 leaving at his last and usual place of abode, a written notice 13 signed by him stating the time and place of sale, and the 14 amount of taxes due. In case of non-resident owners of 15 real estate, notice shall be sent by mail to the last and 16 usual address, if known to the collector, at least ten days 17 before the day of sale. If such tax is paid before the time 18 of sale, the amount to be paid for such advertisement and 19 notice shall not exceed one dollar, in addition to the sum 20 paid to the printer if any.'
