STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter three hundred and fifteen of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to the Salary of the Assistant Librarian of the Maine State Library.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section nine of chapter three hundred and fifteen of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three is hereby amended by striking out in the third line 4 of said section, the words "five hundred dollars" and inserting in place thereof, 'eight hundred dollars,' so that said 6 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 9. The salary of the librarian shall be twelve
8 hundred dollars. He shall employ one regular assistant
9 librarian whose salary shall be eight hundred dollars, the
10 sums stated shall be in full for all services rendered in con-
11 nection with the library.'
