STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to the Salary of the County Commissioners
of Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of January in the
2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
3 seven, the compensation of each of the county commis-
4 sioners of the county of Cumberland shall be a salary, the
5 chairman shall receive the sum of ten hundred and fifty
6 dollars and each of the other commissioners shall receive
7 the sum of nine hundred and fifty dollars annually, payable
8 from the county treasury, in quarterly payments, on the
9 first days of April, July, October and January, in full for all

10 services, expenses and travel, including the management of
11 the jail workshop and the sale of its products, except actual
12 necessary cash expenses incurred outside of the county for
13 the transaction of official business, all bills for such expenses
14 to be approved by the clerk of courts and county attorney
15 of said county; at least a majority of said board shall be
16 in attendance at their office in Portland on all secular days
17 except when official business calls them elsewhere.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are
2 hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
