IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to service of process on Foreign Corporations acting as Trustees under Mortgages.

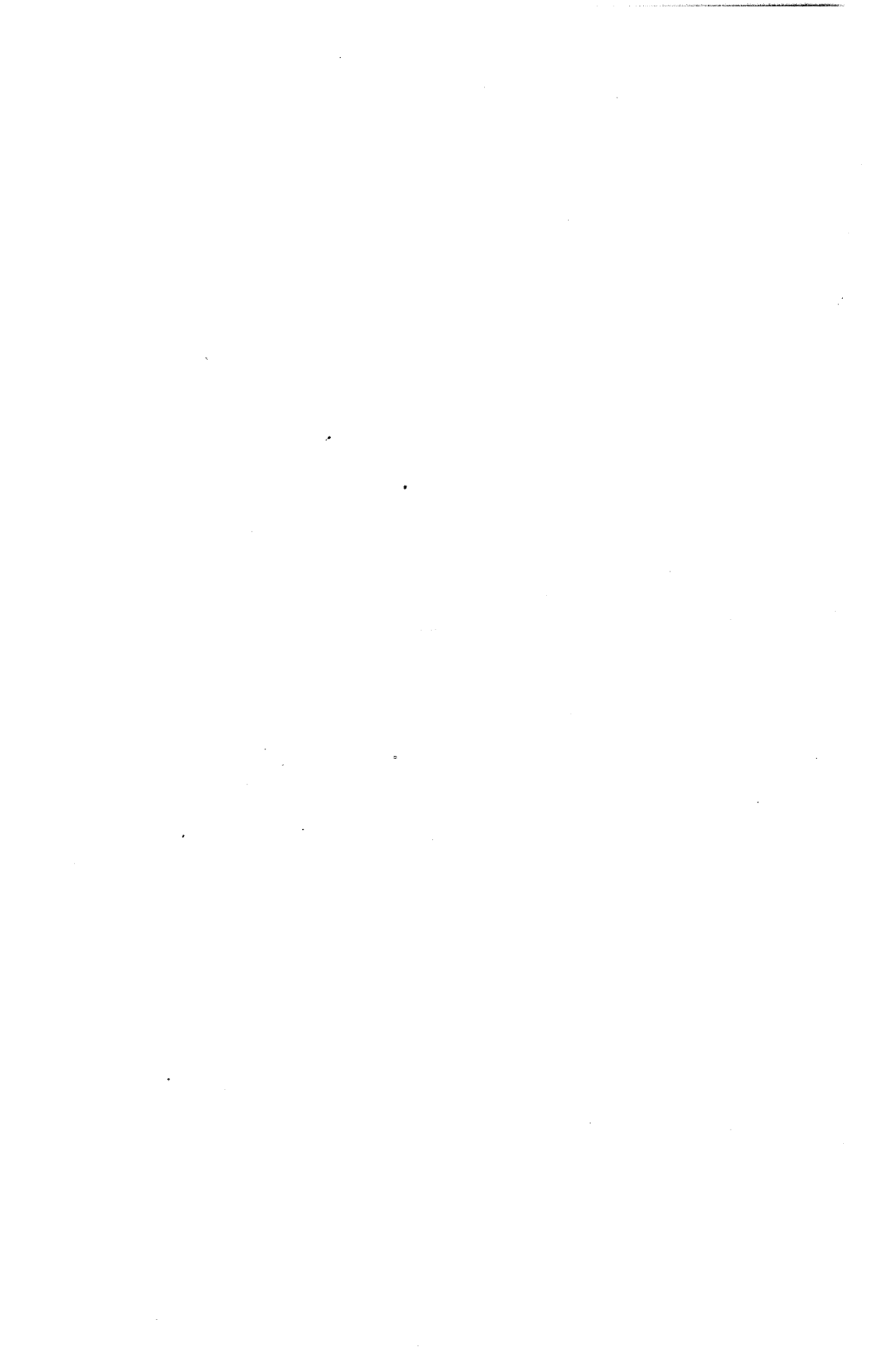
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In case of the mortgage of the franchises,
2 lands or other hereditaments by any domestic corporation
3 to a foreign corporation as trustee, service of process may
4 be made on any authorized agent of such foreign corpora-
5 tion in the State, or if no such agent can be found, such
6 service may be made upon the bank examiner, who shall
7 immediately notify the corporation by mail.

Service made in either of said methods shall be valid and
9 binding upon the corporation in every respect.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
