STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend chapter 304 of the Public Laws of the
year 1889, in relation to the Compensation of the Sheriff of
the county of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter three hundred and four of the Public
2 Laws of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine is here-
3 by amended by striking out the words "eighty-nine" in
4 the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'ninety-
5 seven' also by striking out the word "three" in the fourth
6 line and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'five' so that said
7 chapter as amended shall read as follows:

‘The sheriff of the county of Aroostook, from and after
9 the first day of January of the year eighteen hundred and
10 ninety-seven, shall receive from the treasury of said county
11 an annual salary of five hundred dollars in quarterly pay-
12 ments, on the first days January, April, July and October,
13 instead of the compensation provided in section twenty-
14 three of chapter eighty of the Revised Statutes; and it is
15 hereby further provided, that the sheriff of said county shall
16 not receive from any of his deputies any of the fees earned
17 by said deputies, or any percentage thereon after said date.’
