RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of seven thousand and thirty-five
2 dollars (\$7,035.00) be and hereby is appropriated for and in
3 behalf of the Maine State Prison, to be expended under the
4 direction and supervision of the prison inspectors and
5 warden of the State Prison (for the year 1897) for the fol-
6 lowing purposes, to wit.:

9 Brick workshop 350 00
10 Broom house 175 00
11 Harness shop 500 00
