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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE making appropriations for the Penobscot tribe of  
Indians.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid from the State treasury to  
2 the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians for the years of  
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and eighteen hundred  
4 and ninety-eight, to be appropriated for the benefit of said  
5 tribe each year, as follows: Forty-four hundred and twenty-  
6 nine dollars and seventy cents, amount of interest on their  
7 trust fund held by the State, for the benefit of said tribe, for  
8 agricultural purposes, eight hundred dollars each year; for  
9 bounty on crops, two hundred dollars each year; for annuity,  
10 seventeen hundred dollars each year; for salary of agent,  
11 four hundred dollars each year; for instruction in agricul-

12 ture, one hundred dollars each year; for schools, six hundred  
13 dollars each year; for salary of governor, fifty dollars each  
14 year; for salary of lieutenant-governor forty dollars each  
15 year; for salary of Roman Catholic priest, one hundred dol-  
16 lars each year.
